In addition I made handouts of the Warrant and Explanation to assist the residents with answering and perhaps asking questions.

Transfer Stickers: I provided my some rules as we proceed to handout the new Stickers, please feel free to review and modify as you see fit. Playground Equipment: Recreation Director Jenn Shea has provided her efforts to secure a playground to be constructed at the Arundel Municipal Building. Funding for the project will be proposed from the Recreation Park Capital Fund which has around \$80,900 +/- in the account.

NO CASH PUNCH CARDS OR CHECKS MADE OUT TO CASELLA**

-Provided to only those folks who reside in Arundel under the following criteria.

- (a) Vehicle is registered in Arundel (***NOTE person lives in town but takes company vehicle home. They can get a sticker if the legal address on registration says Arundel***)
- (b) They own and reside in a home in Arundel (***FULL AND/OR PART-TIME***)
- (c) They rent in Arundel and can provide a Vehicle Registered in Arundel and/or a lease agreement.

2022 Arundel Community Playground Proposal

2/14/2022

Please see proposed virtual renderings of the play structure, and a plan/sketch of the whole playground. As you can see from the renderings, the play structure offers a variety of slides and climbing opportunities. Additional classic playground items including swings, a merry-go-round, a tire swing, and a see-saw are separate from the play structure. Within the swings, there are 5 sling-style swings, one Zero-Gravity Chair for children, ages 5-12, with physical disabilities, and another for the youngest children and a caregiver, described as follows: **The patented face-to-face design** features a bucket seat for children under five and a comfortable adult swing seat that allows a parent and child (or grandparent and grandchild) to interact with each other and experience one another's facial expressions while at play.

I had hoped to include two pieces of equipment for adult exercise. My thought was that parents might use them while their children are playing on the playground. The pieces of equipment included a recumbent bike, and a Cardio Walker (similar to an elliptical machine). Photos and a brief description are included in packet for your information. I could pursue donations from local businesses for this purpose, if the BOS would like.

I have spoken with Roger, and Arundel Public Works will do the ground work. Roger has estimated approximately \$5000 for gravel. I am requesting to use some of my operating budget (which we will not spend in its entirety this year) for the balance of the playground costs exceeding the balance in the park fund, which stands at \$80,906 as of 1/25/2022.

The playground will be erected as a "community build," which means that the company we purchase it from will send a foreman to provide two days of supervision and instruction to community volunteers. The difference in cost between having the playground professionally installed vs. a community build is approximately \$30,000.

The plan is to go with a dark green/tan color scheme so that the playground will blend with the environment.

I have included the drawings and designed as submitted by GameTime. I am waiting for additional quotes from UltiPlay and Kompan.

I would be happy to attend a future meeting to discuss further if you'd like. I was unable to attend tonight's meeting, but I'd like to get an idea of whether this is something I should continue to pursue, and what concerns there may be. In order to have it come to fruition, the planning portion will need to be finalized by May 1. As soon as Summer Rec season looms, I will be tied up and unable to commit time to the playground effort.

2.4.2 NON-EXEMPT PRIVATE WAYS

All Non-Exempt Private Ways shall be reviewed by the Planning Board in accordance with the procedures of the Arundel Subdivision Regulations prior to the issuance of any building or road construction permits

2.5. EXEMPT PRIVATE WAY REVIEW PROCEDURES

2.5.1. Staff Review Committee Approval Process

All applications for Private Ways shall be reviewed by the Arundel Staff Review Committee, Within thirty (30) days of receiving a complete Private Way application, when the applicant plans on constructing a new road, the Staff Review Committee shall conduct an on-site Public Hearing in which members of the Public are invited to attend and comment. Notifications shall be mailed to all property owners located within two hundred (200) feet of the Private Way, and a public hearing announcement shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation within seven (7) days of the Public Hearing.

Within fifteen (15) days of the Public Hearing, the Committee shall render a decision to approve, deny, or approve the Private Way application with conditions.

When the applicant is seeking approval of a roadway all-ready constructed and wants to expand the number of lots under the exempt use status to no more than 10 lots the applicant may retain an Engineer if the Public Works Director, Town Planner and Code Enforcement Officer collectively agree that one is needed to certify without the need of a public hearing or public meeting that the road has been constructed to meet the standards of Article 2 Section 2.3 of the Street Design and Construction Standards Ordinance. If the applicant is required to upgrade the road to meet the standards of Article 2.3 then the work to meet the standards must be completed and certified prior to the Staff Review Committee signing off on the request without the need for a Public Hearing or Public Meeting.

Alternate Wording II

If a road or drive has been previously constructed and the applicant seeks to obtain approval under the 2-10 exempt lot provisions in Article 2 Section 2.3, the applicant shall request the staff review committee to visit the site and determine if the road meets the required standards. If it can be demonstrated, no further permitting is required.

2.5.2 Approval Criteria:

The Staff Review Committee shall review all Private Way applications in accordance with all of the evidence submitted by the applicant, and shall specific findings of fact that the following standards have been met:

1. The proposed Private Way conforms with the design standards of Section 2.3 of this Ordinance.
2. The proposed Private Way has received all applicable State and Federal permits;
3. The proposed Private Way provides adequate soil erosion and sedimentation controls in conformance with section 5.4 of the Arundel Land Use Ordinance;
4. The proposed Private Way will not adversely impact on or off-site drainage systems, particularly municipal systems, and complies with section 5.20 of the Arundel Land Use Ordinance;
5. The proposed Private Way is in conformance with section 5.8 Floodplain Management and section 8.0 Shoreland Zoning regulations of the Arundel land Use Ordinance.
6. The proposed Private Way will not have an adverse impact upon existing vehicle circulation systems and safety within the neighborhood and community.

2.6 RECORDING OF PLAN:

An approved and signed Private Way plan shall be recorded by the applicant in the York County Registry of Deeds within sixty (60) days of the signing of the plan. Failure to register the plan within the 60 days will void the Staff Review Committee's approval.

Question 2: Do you wish to continue the budget validation referendum process in Regional School Unit No. 21 for an additional three years?

INFORMATIONAL NOTE ON QUESTION 2:

A “YES” vote will require Regional School Unit No. 21 to continue to conduct a referendum to validate its annual school budget for the next three years.

A “NO” vote will discontinue the budget validation referendum for at least three years and provide instead that the annual school budget shall be finally adopted at a meeting of the voters of Regional School Unit No. 21.

The voting on Questions 1 and 2 shall be by secret ballot referendum. The polls must be opened at 8:00 a.m. and closed at 8:00 p.m.






